

# Hock of ages for \$5000

There's already a healthy market for vintage wines and cars and now it's time for the humble ham to join the party. Last week a seven-year aged Spanish ham went on sale at **Terry Wright's** store in Randwick with a \$5000 ticket price. **Jesus Garcia** from Spanish producer **Joselito** has been in Sydney talking up the product and its "concentration of flavours the ageing process brings". Wright (pictured) imported 12 of the hams, selling most to restaurants and private investors. Spanish architect **Rafael Moneo** designed an internally-lit display case that comes with each ham. It's a long way from the days when the most exciting decoration in a butcher shop was sawdust.
